Statement by IMF Resident Representative for Bosnia and Herzegovina

Francisco Parodi, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) Resident Representative in Bosnia and Herzegovina, issued the following statement in Sarajevo today:

“Republika Srpska Prime Minister Željka Cvijanović and Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina Prime Minister Fadil Novalić met with Nadeem Ilahi, IMF Mission Chief for Bosnia and Herzegovina, in Washington yesterday. They had productive discussions on progress to date with the authorities’ reform agenda and possible future engagement of the IMF with Bosnia and Herzegovina. Close consultations are expected to continue in the coming days on ways to make further progress in these discussions and to agree on the timing of the IMF team’s next mission to Bosnia and Herzegovina.”
