Economist Position

Duties and responsibilities: Assisting the Resident Representative in monitoring and reporting on economic developments of importance for IMF activities in Bosnia and Herzegovina; maintaining good working relationships with interlocutors; and providing inputs to economic policy formulation. The position requires long hours of work, frequent travel, and intense non-hierarchical teamwork.

Qualifications: At least 5 years experience as a professional handling macroeconomic policy issues with a master's degree in economics. Ability to conduct technical discussions and to write reports in English and BiH languages is essential. Familiarity with budget policy issues and the budget process in Bosnia and Herzegovina would be a distinct advantage. Good communication and computer skills.
