

Takatoshi Kato Senior Adviser to the President Japan Center for International Finance (JCIF)

Mr. Takatoshi Kato assumed office of the President of Japan Center for International Finance on September 2010.

From 2004-2010, Mr. Kato served as Deputy Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Kato has held a series of senior positions at the Ministry of Finance of Japan. These include Vice-Minister of Finance for International Affairs (1995-97), and Director-General of the International Finance Bureau (1993-95). From 1985-87, he served as Executive Director for Japan at the Asian Development Bank (ADB).

He has a B.A. from Tokyo University and M.P.A. from Princeton University.

Mr. Kato resigned the President last September 2017, and has continued to be a Senior Adviser to the President of JCIF.
