

The Japan-IMF Scholarship Program for Asia provides scholarships to around 35 young policymakers from Asia-Pacific economies every year to pursue graduate degrees in Japan. More than 950 individuals from 24 countries have received scholarships so far and over 880 individuals have graduated with degrees.
