

Press Statement – June 13, 2011 – for immediate release

An IMF team from headquarters in Washington, DC, USA, has arrived in Skopje. The team, consisting of 5 IMF staff members and headed by Mr. Wes McGrew, will conduct surveillance of the Macedonian economy between June 15 and 22. This kind of surveillance is performed regularly for all 187 IMF member countries. A link to the most recent IMF staff report of January 2011 is provided below.

In addition to economic surveillance, the team is also looking forward to continuing discussions on Macedonia's Precautionary Credit line arrangement.
