

Maputo headline inflation – February 2012

Main facts:

- The Maputo headline CPI recorded unusual negative rate in February (-0.5 percent). As a result, the end of period inflation came further down to 2.5 percent, a remarkable decline from previous 4.3 percent. Average also trended downwards to 8.2 percent (it was 9.3 percent in January).
- Food prices once more were the major driver of this favorable result. Declining transportation costs (car sales category to a large extent) came second.
- Core inflation¹ followed the declining trend. It dropped to 2.4 percent (coming from previous 4.7 percent.



¹ This core inflation measures excludes food, energy and fuels consumption from the total inflation.
