Jerome Vacher, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) Resident Representative in Ukraine, issued the following statement in Kyiv today:

"Nikolay Gueorguiev, a Bulgarian national, has been appointed mission chief for Ukraine. Mr. Gueorguiev has extensive experience working on emerging markets. Most recently he has been mission chief for Moldova and Croatia. Mr. Gueorguiev is replacing Mr Jarvis as mission chief, effective June 4, and will come to Kiev for a brief introductory visit in late June. "
