Mr. Yang is currently the Resident Representative of the International Monetary Fund for Pacific island countries. Prior to his current assignment in September 2010, he was a deputy division chief of the Low-Income Country Strategy Unit at the IMF's Strategy, Policy and Review Department. Before joining the IMF in 2001, he was a Senior Lecturer at The Australian National University, where he taught for 10 years. Mr. Yang's most recent research focuses on monetary policy transmission mechanisms in Pacific island countries and the role of emerging donors in the economic development of low-income countries, and economic growth in the Pacific.
