1. Background

General objectives


- Reduce reporting burden on NSIs
- More efficient use of resources in International Organisation (IO)
- Ensure high quality and consistency of data of official statistics
- Improve global data dissemination

SDMX

- Technical/statistical standards
- New exchange modes (hubs)
- Clear rules and responsibilities



2. A possible data cooperation model





3. Infrastructure

- **Agreed statistical standards**
SNA 2008, ESA 2010, BPM6, manuals
- **Agreed data structures (templates)**
Agreed SDMX data structures for exchanging national data from national to international and between international organisations
- **Maintenance agreements**
Ownership group and maintaining agency in place
- **Streamlined exchange processes**
Frequency and timeliness, data quality management



4. IAG Pilot projects – achievements

- **Scope**

Pilot 1: GDP main aggregates & population

Pilot 2: detailed sector accounts

- **Achievements to date**

1. Agreed data structures (**SDMX-NA package**)

2. Agreed exchange templates

3. Successful push transmissions for pilot 1
(by Eurostat, OECD, IMF)


4. Recognition by IAG, within IO's and by data providers

4. IAG Pilot projects – next steps

- **Continued pilot testing**
 1. practical arrangements between IO's
 2. minor technical configurations
- **Implementation**
 1. Further automation of processes within local systems
 2. Inclusion of data received into internal DB
 3. "Go-Live" of pilot 1 (main aggregates & population): **inclusion of data into external DB**
 4. Launch of pilot 2 with a timeline to be agreed after ESA2010 data are available
 5. Discussion on data validation rules
