I. REGISTRATION

The registration desk will be available from April 11–17. The process is very efficient but to avoid delays, you may want to complete this the day before the event.

III. TRANSPORTATION

Delegation cars, staff cars, or other private vehicles will not be allowed to enter the security perimeter once it is in place from 7:00 p.m. on Friday, April 15 to Sunday, April 17. However, delegations may request one vehicle permit per delegation for entry into the World Bank U Building

garage (access from 18th Street between F and G Streets) to drop off participants. **This permit,** which will be required for entry into the U Building garage, will be valid for use only on Saturday, April 16 (beginning at 5:30 a.m.) and Sunday, April 17. Cars bearing this permit may also wait in the U Building garage to pick up passengers. A vehicle permit can be obtained by sending an e-mail to <u>delegatecarpermit@imf.org</u> and providing the name of the member country delegation for which the permit is required. Permits will be issued beginning April 11.

Shuttle bus service will be offered to and from the official Spring Meetings hotels, on Saturday, April 16 from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Sunday, April 17, from 6:00 a.m. until approximately 5:00 p.m. You must have your Spring Meetings badge (retrieved from the registration desk) to benefit from this service.

Please note that we will not be providing airport transportation for attendees.
