Mexico's ranking in the world

- The No.1 producer of silver in the world
- One of the Top 10 producers of the following 16 minerals: silver, bismuth, fluorite, celestite, wollastonite, cadmium, molybdenum, lead, zinc, diatomite, salt, barite, graphite, gypsum, gold and copper.
- It is the country that attracts most investment in mining exploration in Latin America and by that token ranks fourth in the world, according to the report published by SNL Metals & Mining 2015.
- It is the country with the fifth best mining investment environment in the world, according to a report published by Behre Dolbear consultants in August 2015.

The mining and metallurgy sector in Mexico

- It accounts for 4 percent of Mexico's Gross National Product.
- In July 2015, it was generating 352,666 direct jobs and more than 1.6 million indirect jobs, according to the Mexican Social Security Institute's report.
- In Mexico, 62 companies fall within the sphere of competence of the General Administration for Large Taxpayers (AGGC): 35 Mexican enterprises and 27 foreign enterprises, pertaining to 11 domestic and 20 foreign groups.
