

OAP: Role and Activities

- Surveillance and research: Regional and bilateral surveillance; and research on Asian and Pacific economies
- Outreach: Monthly Current Economic Issues seminars; WEO/REO seminars; lectures; and media outreach in the region
- Capacity Building: Training seminars for country officials; Japan-IMF Scholarship Program for Asia (JISPA); and Japan-IMF Macroeconomic Seminar for Asia (JIMS)
- Relationship Building: Joint international conferences; representing the IMF in regional fora (ASEAN, ASEAN+3, APEC, SEACEN, etc.); and coordinating APD Regional Advisory Group


