## RAMÓN ESPINASA



Ramón Espinasa is the Lead Oil and Gas specialist at the Energy Division of the Inter-American Development Bank (IADB). For twenty years up to 1999 worked at Petróleos de Venezuela (PDVSA) where he was Chief Economist between 1992 and 1999.

Michael John is currently Manager - Projects in the Strategy and Business Development Department of The Petroleum Company of Trinidad and Tobago (Petrotrin), a position he has held since 2011. In addition he serves as a part-time lecturer in Energy Economics at The University of the West Indies St Augustine.
