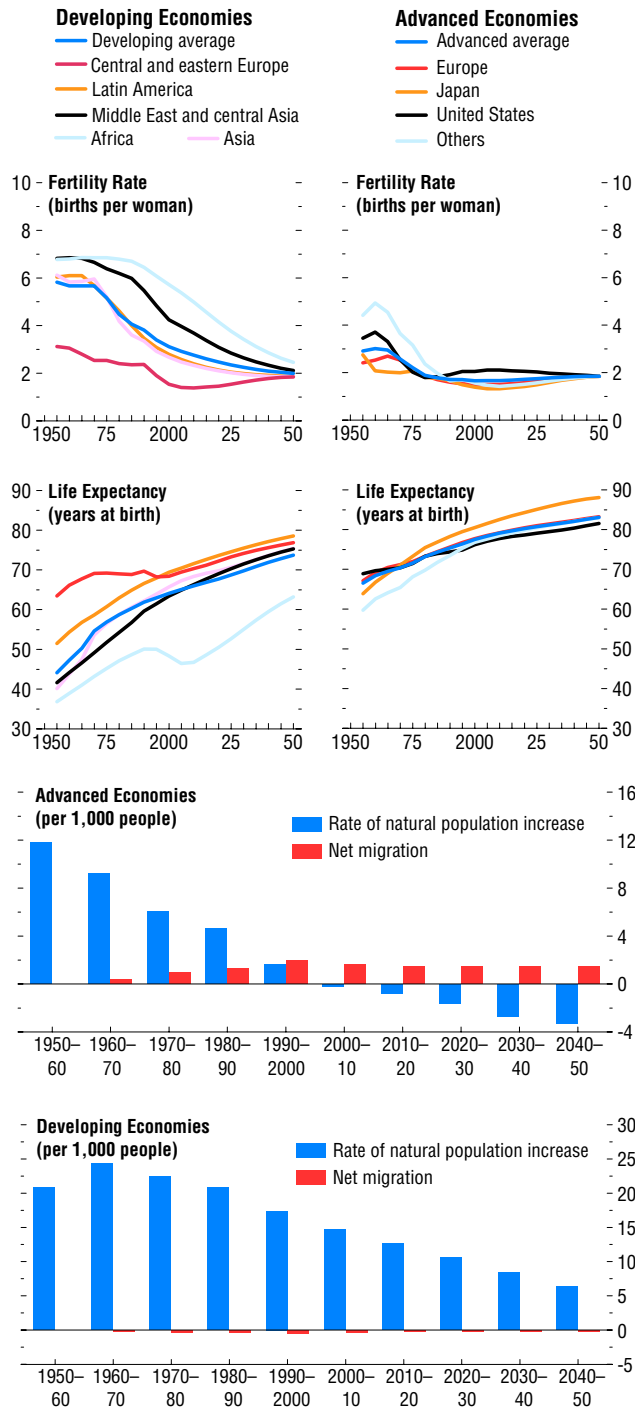


Figure 3.2. Key Demographic Trends, 1950–2050
